LETTER FROM THE TRUSTEE CHAIR

As a parent, it is important that I give my children a solid educational foundation to equip and prepare them to succeed in a changing world. The Montessori School of Columbia does exactly that. Our children are encouraged to be active learners, think for themselves, try new experiences, celebrate their accomplishments and learn and grow from their mistakes – all in a safe and nurturing environment. I could not have asked for more.

Three years ago the Board and Staff met to discuss how we could grow the school while maintaining a superb, authentic Montessori academic program. Our goals were to make these opportunities available to more children, increase educational activities beyond the classroom, provide optimal spaces for all the school's needs, and implement best practices in the management of the school.

Thanks to your support, and the dedication of our staff and Board, I am happy to report that we are very close to achieving all of these ambitious goals.

Over the past three years, the school has expanded to offer 3 primary classrooms; acquired ownership of a block of Oceola Street; added an enrichment center for language, arts and a library; built a beautiful new building for the elementary classrooms; created an ideal space for our younger primary students' afternoon work; provided a specially prepared space for aftercare; added an administration building; built a garden and a chicken habitat.

We also began an annual survey of parents — and appreciate everyone who responded. Your input has led to the creation of a Summer Program and the addition of physical education, extra-curricular and after-school activities including soccer, chorus, karate, gymnastics and a chess club. The Board and Head of School continue to look for ways to add requested new programs and classrooms.

All of this has been funded by growing enrollment, responsible borrowing and your support of the Annual Fund and other fundraising efforts. This support has been critical in keeping tuition increases modest as the school continues to provide an exemplary education at an extraordinary value.

In the coming years we aspire to add a new lower elementary class so we can accommodate all our rising kindergartners; build a new elementary classroom; enhance the information parents receive about their child's learning; improve the campus grounds; and focus on nurturing the diversity of our school community. With the benefit of your ideas, time and support, the future of the Montessori School of Columbia and our children is bright indeed.

LETTER FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL

Dear Friends,

More than 33 years ago six families came together to bring Montessori elementary education to Columbia, founding the Montessori School of Columbia. It is remarkable to reflect on the growth and success of our school during the past three decades, and, of course, to look to our future.

Last year, we constructed our first building from the ground up: perhaps the most notable undertaking in our school's history. But there is much more to report, and it is with great pride and thanks that we highlight some of our proudest accomplishments.

During the 2015-2016 academic year, we exceeded our enrollment goals as our programs reached their highest level ever with 116 students. We generated an extensive wait list for the first time in our history, and we added a high-quality summer camp for our primary students.

One of our most impacting recent events was one that no one expected — the thousand year flood in October 2015. We saw unprecedented property damage but, more importantly, we felt the devastation to individual lives and hearts. As a result, we witnessed first-hand the extensive "work of water" that is central to Montessori classrooms and curriculum. In response, our upper elementary students went to a Richland County Shelter to sort and distribute supplies for flood victims.

The school year had many happy occasions, too. The beginning of the school year brought with it a new logo, three new teaching assistants, multiple new families, and a new building. At the start of our fiscal year, we received a \$10,000 donation from an anonymous Cheerful Giver. Money earned at the previous year's Auction and Fund-a-Need were used to send Ms. Viji and Ms. Betty to the annual AMS conference in Chicago. We welcomed renowned author, Jane Bluestein in October, and we hosted our school's first Grandparents' Day in April.

The construction of our new elementary building was complete in May, and our first-through-sixth graders enjoyed a sleepover in the newly constructed, empty building. With the help of students and parents, we then moved our elementary classrooms into the new structure. The building we had dreamed of for more than 20 years became a reality for us last year.

Our academic excellence and our school's financial prosperity are due in no small measure to the hard work, dedication, and energy of our trustees, teachers, administrators, parents, and children. On behalf of MSC, I thank you for your time, talent, and commitment, and I look forward to your continuous support in the future. I'm fortunate and proud to lead such a wonderful school.
